June 8, 2018 at Las Vegas

LAS VEGAS (AP) Tiffany Hayes scored 24 points, Angel McCoughtry had 23 points, nine rebounds and six assists and the Atlanta Dream beat the Las Vegas Aces 87-83 on Friday.

Atlanta went on an 8-0 run midway through the third quarter to extend its lead to 54-37, and McCoughtry put the Dream ahead 87-75 with 2:10 remaining in the fourth. Jaime Nared capped the scoring at the free-throw line with 1.6 seconds left.

Renee Montgomery scored 11 points for Atlanta (4-3), which handed Connecticut its first loss of the season Tuesday. Hayes and McCoughtry combined to make 14 of 15 free throws.

Rookie A'ja Wilson, averaging 21.0 points, had 20 points, nine rebounds and three assists for Las Vegas (1-6). She was 6 of 18 from the floor. Kayla McBride had 13 points and six rebounds.

August 12, 2017 at San Antonio

SAN ANTONIO (AP) Isabelle Harrison scored 23 points and the San Antonio Stars beat Atlanta 84-68 on Saturday night, handing the Dream their seventh straight loss.

Kayla McBride and Moriah Jefferson added 14 points apiece and Kelsey Plum had 10 as the Stars (7-22) won for the fourth time in five games after starting the season 0-14.

Brittney Sykes scored 28 points and Elizabeth Williams had 16 with five blocks for the Dream (10-18), who have lost eight in a row on the road.

San Antonio led 23-19 after the first quarter and two baskets by Jefferson in the middle of an 8-0 run pushed the lead to 37-27 late in the second quarter. After a basket Sykes ended the run, the Stars ended the half with a 7-2 run, taking a 43-31 lead at the half.

Atlanta got within nine once midway through the third quarter but trailed 68-54 entering the fourth and never got closer.

July 18, 2017 at Atlanta

ATLANTA (AP) Tiffany Hayes scored 25 points and Brittney Sykes added a career-best 20 to lead the Atlanta Dream to an 88-75 win over the San Antonio Stars on Tuesday.

Atlanta trailed by 10 after one quarter before rallying behind Hayes. She had 12 of her points in the second quarter as the Dream (9-10) cut its deficit to 39-37 at the half.

Sykes, who has scored in double figures in nine straight games, took over in the second half as the Dream pulled away from the Stars (2-18).

Isabelle Harrison scored 22 points to lead San Antonio despite rolling her ankle in the first half. San Antonio was missing Kayla McBride, who injured her ankle in the team's last game.

The Dream head to Washington to play the Mystics in their final game before the All-Star break.

Collen Takes Defensive Approach

Head Coach Nicki Collen has preached defense since she took over the Dream this offseason. Her approach is starting to show as Atlanta is allowing 78.2 per game and are recording 7.6 steals and 5.1 blocks per contest.

Dream Record-Breaking Win Streak

The Atlanta Dream have set a new franchise record with eight straight wins. The previous record was six straight, which was done three times in history.

Dream Setting Offensive Records

The Dream was only the second team in WNBA history to finish with four players with 20+ points (24-Angel McCoughtry, 23-Jessica Breland, 21-Tiffany Hayes, 21-Renee Montgomery) when they did it against the Washington Mystics on July 11, 2018. The last time was Phoenix in a 2OT game vs Minnesota on July 24, 2010.

Atlanta also recorded a season-high 31 assists against the Mystics, good for second all-time in franchise history (32 - at Sacramento, Sept. 4, 2009).

Against the Indiana Fever on July 13, 2018, the Dream saw seven players score at least 10+ points in the same game for the first time in franchise history.

Elias Sports said Tiffany Hayes' game-winning field goal at Conencticut (7/17) was the longest (46.7 FT) game-winner made in the last 10 seconds of a regular-season game in WNBA history.

Renee Montgomery set a new franchise record by knocking down seven three-point field goals at win vs New York (7/19). She passed Betty Lenox, who scored six twice in 2018.

Angel Creeping Up Career Scoring List

Angel McCoughtry now ranks 15th overall among WNBA career scoring leaders at 5,447 career points- She became the second fastest in league history to 5,000 points to reach the 5,000 point total behind Diana Taurasi. The star continues to break records, including setting a new high of 39 points in a game against the New York Liberty (6/19).

Angel McCoughtry has always been talked about as a scorer but she does it on the defensive side of the ball as well. She is a perennial member of the WNBA All-Defensive team and is now ranked 10th place all-time with 597 career steals.

Averaging 17.7 points, Tiffany Hayes has topped 2,500 career points over her 6+ year career in the WNBA. The standout guard has 2,824 points so far. She has ten 20+ games in 2018 through 25 games played.

Tiffany Among League Leaders in Free Throw Attempts

Known for her ability to get to the basket, Tiffany Hayes has also shown the ability to draw fouls and get to the free throw line. She is attempting 5.0 per game this season.

She tied the Atlanta Dream franchise record for attempts in one quarter when she shot 12 in the 1st Quarter against hte Indiana Fever on June 14, 2018.

Dream Dominating Eastern Conference Player of the Week Awards

Tiffany Hayes has been named POW three times this season, most recently for the week of August 5th. She ranked first in the Eastern Conference in scoring (21.7 ppg) while connecting on 53.3 percent of her shots from the field (24-of-45), including 10-of-21 (47.6) from three-point range. Hayes also averaged 3.0 rebounds and 2.0 assists for the week.

The first nomation (6/10) Hayes was selected Player of the Week for the first time in her seven seasons. Behind Hayes, Atlanta went 3-0 against Connecticut, Las Vegas and Seattle to improve its record to 5-3. She paced Eastern Conference players in points (23.0 ppg) and led all scorers in each of her three games.

The second nomination (7/22) Hayes ranked second in the Eastern Conference in scoring (18.0 ppg) to go with 4.7 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game. The highlight of the week for the 5-10 guard came on July 17, when she made a game-winning, buzzer-beating half-court shot to complete an 18-point effort as Atlanta defeated the host Connecticut Sun 86-83.

Nicki Collen Named Coach of the Month

Collen guided the East-leading Dream to a 9-2 mark in July, which tied the Seattle Storm for the league's best record for the month. Atlanta went 4-0 on the road and 5-2 at home to improve to 16-10 overall, moving from ninth place to second in the league standings.

The Dream won a franchise-best eight consecutive games during July, highlighted by an 87-74 home win over the league-leading Storm on July 22. In its four road games, Atlanta posted wins over the Indiana Fever, Washington Mystics, Connecticut Sun and Los Angeles Sparks.

Renee Montgomery Sharp Shooting This Season

Renee Montgomery broke the franchise record for most three-pointers in a game against New York Liberty (7/19) with seven. She surpassed Betty Lennox who held the record with six three pointers made in a game twice. During WNBA All-Star game Montgomery competed in the 3-Point Contest at halftime and notched 18 points, good for fifth place. She has hit the second most three pointers in a season in franchise history with 56. She needs just eight more to break the franchise record to pass Lennox (63 in 2008).

Dream Swap Clarendon, Pick for Bentley

The Atlanta Dream traded Layshia Clarendon and a 2019 second round pick to the Connecticut Sun for Alex Bentley on Monday, July 9. Bentley played for the Dream as a rookie in 2013.

Angel McCoughtry Named to WNBA All-Star 2018

Angel McCoughtry earned her fifth selection to the WNBA All-Star when it was announced on Tuesday, July 17. She will represent the Dream at the game in Minnesota on Saturday, July 28. She will play on Team Parker after being selected by captain Candace Parker.

Jessica Breland Named Player of the Week (7/9)

Breland was selected Player of the week for the first time in her seven-year career. She led the Eastern Conference in rebounding (9.3 rpg) and blocked shots (2.67 bpg), ranked sixth in scoring (14.7 ppg) and finished fifth in field goal percentage (54.1, 20-of-37). Behind Breland, Atlanta went 3-0 and extended its winning streak to four games.

Angel McCoughtry Named Player of the Week (6/25)

McCoughtry was selected Player of the Week for the 16th time in her nine seasons. She averaged a WNBA-high 32.0 points per game and paced the league in minutes (35.2 mpg) last week as Atlanta went 1-1. She was also first among Eastern Conference players in rebounding (11.0 rpg), sixth in free throw percentage (83.9, 26-of-31) and 10th in assists (3.0 apg).

Five Dream Players on USA Basketball National Team Pool

The Dream are well represented on the nation scene with five players - Layshia Clarendon, Tiffany Hayes, Angel McCoughtry, Brittney Sykes and Elizabeth Williams - named to the 2018-20 USA Basketball Women's National Team athlete pool. Clarendon, Hayes and Williams suited up for the national team's exhibition game against China on Thursday, April 26 in Seattle, Wash.

Dream Draft Three in 2018 WNBA Draft

The Atlanta Dream selected three standout seniors in the 2018 WNBA Draft. The team selected Monique Billings (UCLA) No. 15 overall, Kristy Wallace (Baylor) at No. 16 and Mackenzie Engram (Georgia) at No. 27 overall. Wallace will sit out the 2018 WNBA season due to an ACL tear suffered in March.

Dream Make Splash in 2018 Free Agency

Head Coach Nicki Collen wasted no time looking to improve the Dream. The first-year head coach signed two of the top free agents available in the 2018 class in guard Renee Montgomery (Minnesota) and Jessica Breland (Chicago). Both players are expected to see significant minutes for the Dream in 2018.

WNBA Announces "Take A Seat, Take A Stand"

The WNBA launched "Take a Seat, Take a Stand," its new women and girls empowerment program for the 2018 season. WNBA tickets will do more than support women's sports – when fans take a seat at a WNBA game, they will also have the chance to support several organizations that are changing the game for women and girls.For each ticket purchased, the WNBA will donate \$5 to one of six organizations of the fans' choosing in addition to a ticket to send a young woman or girl to a game to inspire her by the strength, talent and leadership of the women of the WNBA.

GM Survey Recognizes Dream as Most Improved

Atlanta was recognized as the most improved team (50 percent) and the one that made the best offseason moves (50 percent) after signing veteran free agents Renee Montgomery and Jessica Breland and re-signing two-time WNBA scoring leader and fourtime All-WNBA selection Angel McCoughtry, who sat out the 2017 season to rest.

Nicki Collen was named head coach of the Atlanta Dream on October 30, 2017.

Earning her first head coaching position, Collen came to the Dream after pair of successful seasons as an assistant coach for the Connecticut Sun. Working for 2017 WNBA Coach of the Year Curt Miller, Collen helped the Sun compile an impressive 21-13 record and finished with the fourth-best regular season record in the WNBA, earning the franchise's first postseason appear-

ance since 2012. Connecticut, who lost former No. 1 pick Chiney Ogwumike to injury prior to the 2017 season, improve on a 14-20 record in 2016.

Prior to moving to Connecticut, Collen served under head coach Karl Smesko at Florida Gulf Coast. Joining the staff in July of 2014, Collen helped guide the Eagles to consecutive 30-win seasons. The 2015-16 team completed a 33-6 campaign with a trip to the WNIT Championship game, where it was edged by South Dakota on April 2nd. The 2014-15 Eagles were 31-3 with a 26-game winning streak and an undefeated record in the Atlantic Sun Conference. That team also made history with its first Division I national ranking and its first NCAA Tournament victory, a 75-67 win over 10th-seeded Oklahoma State.

Before moving to FGCU, Collen enjoyed great success as an assistant coach at Arkansas, Louisville, Ball State and Colorado State. During her nine seasons as an assistant coach at the collegiate level, Collen helped teams reach three NCAA tournaments and five WNITs.

Collen played one year of professional basketball with the BCM Alexandros team in Greece.

As a player at Purdue, Collen was a member of Big 10 championship teams that advanced to the Final Four in 1994 and the Elite Eight in 1995. Collen transferred to Marquette as a junior, competing in two more NCAA tournaments while also securing a Bachelor of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering.

Collen and her husband Tom have three children, Connor, Reese and Logan.


