PROBABLE STARTERS

F #25 MONIQUE BILLINGS 6-4 | 192 | UCLA

2020: Ranked 4th in the league with 58 offensive rebounds and 2.6 offensive boards per game, while her 187 total and 8.5 rebounds per game both ranked 7th in the league... Started the season with a career night against Dallas (7/26), leading the team with 30 points and 13 rebounds for her second career double-double... Her 30 points led all scorers opening weekend.

F #40 SHEKINNA STRICKLEN 6-2 | 230 | Tennessee

2020: Finished first season with the Dream with 6.1 points, 1.9 rebounds and 0.6 assists per game ... Shot a season-high 8 three-pointers against Seattle (8/6) and again against Connecticut (8/10) ... Knocked down 6 three's in the first half against Connecticut (8/10), just one off the WNBA record of 7 three's in one half (Kelsey Mitchell, 2019).

C #1 ELIZABETH WILLIAMS 6-3 | 192 | Duke

2020: WNBA First Team All-Defense ... Started in all 22 games ... Shot a perfect 7-for-7 from the field in the Dream's season opener against Dallas (7/26), tying the franchise record (last by Aneika Henry, at Tulsa, June 29, 2012) ... Took over as the Dream's all-time leading shot blocker with 6 against NYL (9/3), bringing her to 283 total career blocks in a Dream uniform.

G #10 COURTNEY WILLIAMS 5-8 | 133 | South Florida

2020: Led all guards in the league in rebounding (11th with 1.9 offensive rebounds per game, 13th with 7.2 total rebounds and 5.3 defensive rebounds per game) ... Saw a streak of 12-straight games with double-digit scoring, a run that included four 20+ point outings and one 30-point performance ... Recorded four double-doubles.

G #3 CHENEDY CARTER 5-9 | 143 | Texas A&M

2020: WNBA All-Rookie Team ... Her 17.4 points per game ranked 8th in the league and paced all rookies ... Became the youngest player in WNBA history to score 30 points at 21 years and 266 days when she put up 35 against Seattle (8/6) ... Scored at least 25 points on four occasions, becoming the fourth first-year player to score 25+ points in a game for Atlanta.

THE SALE OF THE ATLANTA DREAM

FEBRUARY 26, 2021

The WNBA and NBA Boards of Governors have unanimously approved the sale of the Atlanta Dream to Larry Gottesdiener, Chairman of Northland, an industry-leading national real estate firm. The three-member investor group is comprised of former Dream star Renee Montgomery, Northland President and Chief Operating Officer Suzanne Abair, and Gottesdiener.

“With the unanimous WNBA and NBA votes, today marks a new beginning for the Atlanta Dream organization and we are very pleased to welcome Larry Gottesdiener and Suzanne Abair to the WNBA,” said WNBA Commissioner Cathy Engelbert. “I admire their passion for women’s basketball, but more importantly, have been impressed with their values. I am also thrilled that former WNBA star Renee Montgomery will be joining the ownership group as an investor and executive for the team. Renee is a trailblazer who has made a major impact both in the game and beyond.”

“It is a privilege to join a team of inspiring women who strive for excellence on the court and equity off the court,” said Larry Gottesdiener. “I would like to express my gratitude to Commissioner Engelbert, Commissioner Silver, and the WNBA and NBA Boards of Governors for the opportunity.”

Two-time WNBA champion Renee Montgomery will be the first former player to become both an owner and executive of a WNBA team. Montgomery sat out the 2020 season to focus on social justice issues and recently announced her retirement from the league after 11 seasons.

NOTES AND STORYLINES

New Ownership Group

WNBA and NBA Boards of Governors unanimously approved the sale of the Atlanta Dream to Larry Gottesdiener, Chairman of Northland, an industry-leading national real estate firm on February 26, 2021. The three-member investor group is comprised of former Dream star Renee Montgomery, Northland President and Chief Operating Officer Suzanne Abair, and Gottesdiener.

The sale made two-time WNBA champion Renee Montgomery the first former player to become both an owner and executive of a WNBA team. Montgomery sat out the 2020 season to focus on social justice issues and recently announced her retirement from the league after 11 seasons.

Returning Players

Dream veteran Tiffany Hayes returns to the Dream's roster this season after choosing to sit out the 2020 WNBA season. Hayes comes back to the league after leading Perfumerias Avenida in Spain to a Endesa Women's League championship and a second place finish in the EuroLeague.

In addition to Hayes, the Dream are returning six players from the 2020 season, four of which have yet to play a true home game in Atlanta as they were added just prior to the league's Florida bubble season. Kalani Brown, Chennedy Carter, Shekinna Stricklen and Courtney Williams will all play their first season calling Atlanta home in 2021.

WNBA All-Rookie honoree Carter and WNBA All-Defensive team member Elizabeth Williams return after impressive performances in the WNBA bubble last season. Carter became the youngest player in league history to score 35 or more points, and Williams took over as the Dream's all-time leading shot blocker, tallying 288 over her five years with Atlanta. Monique Billings returns for her fourth season in a Dream uniform.

New Additions

Five new players joined the team this year, with Tianna Hawkins, Cheyenne Parker and Odyssey Sims being picked up in free agency, Aari McDonald being drafted, and Crystal Bradford joining on a training camp contract.

The team acquired Cheyenne Parker as a free agent in the first day of the signing period after the 6-4 forward saw her most productive season of her six-year career, finishing the 2020 season averaging 13.4 points, 6.4 rebounds, 1.5 assists and 1.3 steals per game – all career-high numbers. Parker will be joined by 6-3 forward Tianna Hawkins in the frontcourt, a WNBA Champion with the Washington Mystics in 2019. Sims saw her most efficient season since her rookie year in 2020, shooting 33.3 percent from range and 90.9 percent from the free throw line with the Minnesota Lynx.

Elizabeth Williams

With Dream veteran Tiffany Hayes choosing to forego the 2020 season, Elizabeth Williams became the Dream's current active leader in nearly every statistical category with 1,577 points, 1,045 rebounds, 288 blocks, 155 games and 4,684 minutes played in a

Dream uniform. She took over as the Dream's team captain this year in her fifth season with the team, and holds the secretary position on the WNBA's Executive Committee.

In her first game of the season, Williams shot a perfect 7-of-7 from the field and 3-of-3 from the charity stripe, tying the franchise record for most field goals without a miss.

Williams set the single game record for the 2020 WNBA season with 6 blocks against New York (9/3), pushing her to 283 total blocks in her five seasons in Atlanta – a new franchise record.

The Bucket Gets Boards

Guard Courtney Williams finished the season leading all guards in the WNBA in rebounds with 143 total (15th in league). Indiana's Julie Allemand followed her as the next true guard with 100 total rebounds (28th). Williams' 7.2 boards per game was ranked 13th in the league.

Dream Draft Three in 2021 WNBA Draft

The Dream drafted three players in the 2021 WNBA Draft, picking guard Aari McDonald out of Arizona with the third overall selection, Spanish star Raquel Carrera with the 15th overall pick and Lindsey Pulliam out of Northwestern with the 27th pick.

At Arizona, McDonald led the Wildcats to the team's first NCAA Finals appearance in 2021, averaging 24.8 points in their six games of the NCAA Tournament, including dropping 33 points against Indiana in the Elite Eight. The 5-6 guard earned Pac-12 Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year awards her redshirt senior year before becoming the first Wildcat to ever be drafted in the first round of a WNBA Draft.

McDonald is still working to finish her masters degree at Arizona, studying Applied Behavior Analysis.

HOLLYWOOD

Chennedy Carter earned a spot on the 2020 WNBA All-Rookie Team after proving herself to not only be one of the top rookies in the league, but one of the best players in the WNBA this season. She now holds the franchise record for points scored by a rookie in a single game (35 vs. Seattle, 8/6), making her the youngest player in league history at 21 years and 266 days old to score 30+ points in a game.

She is just the fourth first-year player to score 25+ points in a game for Atlanta, and the third to score at least 30. It marked just the sixth time in Dream history that a player has recorded 30+ points and 7+ assists in a game (Betty Lenox – 1, Iziane Castro Marques – 1, Angel McCoughtry – 3).

The outing made her the first player in the WNBA to score 35+ points since Indiana's Kelsey Mitchell did it on September 8, 2019.

She is the first Dream rookie to score in double-figures in each of her first six games – a record she set back in her fourth game.

After being sidelined for six games with an ankle injury, Carter returned to the court and looked like her pre-injury self against Los Angeles (8/30), scoring 26 points in 26 minutes.

Carter recorded her fourth 20+ point performance and ninth double-figure outing of the season with 22 points against Indiana (9/1), adding on a team-high 6 assists and a steal.

Finished the season with 17.4 points per game, the 8th-highest in the league and the most of any rookie.

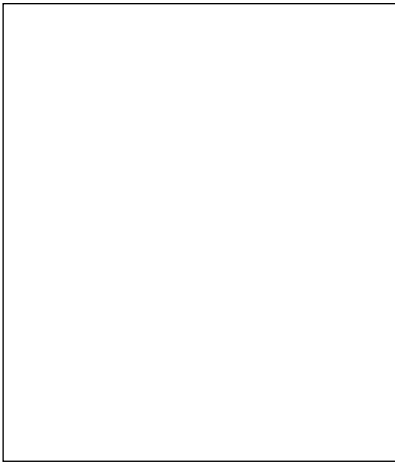
