

To our current and future players, to the legions of worldwide Dream fans, to the city of Atlanta we say: We are here to elevate, win, inspire, and captivate. Together. We are excited about this journey, and we are in it for the long run.

## **Candice Dupree Comes Back Down South**

The Atlanta Dream most recently signed seven-time WNBA All-Star Candice Dupree to a contract on July 26. The Tampa, Fla. native is in her 16<sup>th</sup> year in the league and ranks as one of the top players in WNBA history in the all-time records books.

Dupree has 69 career double-doubles, which stands as the 12<sup>th</sup>-most double-doubles in WNBA history and 5<sup>th</sup>-best among active players. She has recorded a double-double in 14.3% of all games she has played (484).

#### **Aari McDonald Sets Dream Free Throw Record**

Aari McDonald most recently set the Atlanta Dream franchise record with 31 consecutive made free throws. Her 31-straight stood as the longest streak among active players in the league (behind Elena Delle Donne, who has not played since 2019) until she missed her second free throw against Phoenix on 8/15.

### **Darius Taylor Named Interim Assistant Coach**

Prior to the team retuning to Atlanta from the Olympic hiatus, Mike Petersen stepped down from his role as the Dream's Interim Head Coach.

"For health reasons that the grind of the WNBA season will not allow me to adequately address, I have decided to step down from my coaching duties with the Dream," Petersen said. "I want to thank the Atlanta Dream players, staff and ownership for the opportunity to be part of an amazing organization." Darius Taylor was elevated to the head coaching role and will lead the team as a head coach for the first time in his career as the Dream faces Phoenix on August 15.

Taylor's career began at Temple University in the early 2000's as an assistant coach under Dawn Staley (where he coached Candice Dupree). Prior to joining former head coach Nicki Collen's staff in Atlanta along with Mike Petersen, Taylor had left the coaching world, following his now-wife Joni Taylor to Athens as she took over the Georgia Bulldogs women's basketball program.

#### **Ball Thieves**

Atlanta is averaging 9.8 steals per game, the most in the league. It's the 14<sup>th</sup>-highest average all-time by any team and the highest in the WNBA since 2012, when the Dream averaged 9.8 steals per game.

Atlanta is averaging 16.7 opponent turnovers and a 20.1% opponent turnover percentage (both 3<sup>rd</sup> in the league), capitalizing off of those with an average of 17.6 points off turnovers (2<sup>nd</sup> in the league behind Los Angeles - 19.2 per game).

Four players are ranked in the top 20 in the league in steals per game, two are ranked in the top 15 for total steals (official leaders):

Odyssey Sims - 1.4 SPG (7<sup>th</sup>), 28 STL (7<sup>th</sup>) Monique Billings - 1.3 SPG (12<sup>th</sup>), 24 STL (t-17<sup>th</sup>) Crystal Bradford - 1.3 SPG (13<sup>th</sup>), 25 STL (14<sup>th</sup>) Courtney Williams - 1.2 (t-17<sup>th</sup>), 24 STL (t-17<sup>th</sup>)

Tiffany Hayes' 1.5 SPG ranks 6<sup>th</sup> so far this season.

Tiffany Hayes recorded five steals at Washington (6/17) and Cheyenne Parker recorded five against Minnesota (6/23).

- Hayes was the first Dream player to record five in a game since Renee Montgomery did it in 2018.
- The last time two different Dream players had five-steal games was in 2016 (Bria Holmes, Sancho Lyttle) (via Elias). The franchise record is four players with 5+ steals.

#### **Protecting the Glass**

The Dream rank second in the league with 10.0 offensive rebounds per game, jumping up after pulling down 15 at Phoenix (8/15).

Monique Billings ranks third in the league with 2.8 offensive rebounds per game (a career best for her) and an 11.2% offensive rebound percentage.

Courtney Williams leads all guards with 1.3 offensive rebounds per game and 26 total o-boards so far this season (LA's Brittney Sykes is second with 25 total). She also leads all true guards with 6.1 total per game (behind only Connecticut's DeWanna Bonner, who is listed as a forward-guard).

#### **Backcourt Trio**

The backcourt trio of Courtney Williams, Tiffany Hayes and Chennedy Carter is averaging a combined 51.8 points per game in the five games they have played together.

## **Injuries and Rotating Lineups**

The Dream have yet to have a fully healthy roster this season, with Cheyenne Parker, Chennedy Carter, Shekinna Stricklen and Tiffany Hayes all landing on the inactives list at some point this season. Atlanta has not played one game with an empty injury report yet this season.

Shekinna Stricklen played her 300th career game against Indiana (7/11) and Monique Billings played in her 100<sup>th</sup> career game at Connecticut (7/9).

Elizabeth Williams reached 300 career blocks in a Dream uniform with a season-best 3 against Minnesota (6/23).

In the same game, Cheyenne Parker reached 100 career steals with her first steal against Minnesota (6/23). She went on to record 5 in that game, a Dream record for the season.

Tianna Hawkins reached 500 career made field goals with four against Washington (6/13), bringing her to 502 after the game.

Monique Billings reached 500 career rebounds with a team-leading 7 against Chicago (5/25), bringing her to 503 after the game. Billings also reached 500 career points with 2 against Minnesota (6/6).

### Elizabeth Williams, All-Time Blocks Leader

Dream vetaran Elizabeth Williams took over as the Dream's all-time blocks leader, currently sitting at 305 total blocks with the Dream through 19 games this season.

Williams set the single game record for the 2020 WNBA season with 6 blocks against New York (9/3), pushing her to 283 total blocks in her five seasons in Atlanta - a new franchise record.

### **Crystal Bradford**

Guard Crystal Bradford came back to the league this season for the first time since her rookie season in 2015 with Los Angeles. Bradford previously played for Ramat Hasharon in Israel and Besiktas in Turkey.

Crystal Bradford has been highly efficient on a per-minute basis. She has a Player Efficiency Rating (PER) of 19.1 which ranks 20<sup>th</sup> this season among players who have played at least 300 minutes and leads active players on her team. PER is a box-score based estimate of total value contributed by a player per minute.

Bradford leads the league in steal rate at 4.1%. She gets a steal on 4.1% of opponent plays finished (shots, trips to the line, or turnovers) when she is on the floor. The steal rate statistic controls for opportunity including minutes played (via Her Hoop Stats).

## Pro Baller, Mother, and Software Engineer Tianna Hawkins

When Dream forward Tianna Hawkins isn't playing, she is juggling one of her many other responsibilities. Not only is she a mother to her five-year-old son, Emanuel, she is also a part-time software engineer with Microsoft. A graduate of the University of Maryland with a degree in Criminology and Criminal Justice, Hawkins would like to become a federal agent after her professional career. While in college, she even had the opportunity to intern with the Secret Service.

### **OT Win in Barclays**

The Dream beat the New York Liberty 90-87 in overtime on May 29. It marked the Dream's first overtime win since 2017, when the Dream defeated Indiana 79-74 on August 26. It was Atlanta's first game of the year holding their opponent to under 40% shooting. The Dream held New York's Sabrina lonescu to a career-low 6 points, her first ever single-digit scoring game.

#### Four Straight W's

Atlanta won four straight games earlier this season, three of which came in only five days. The last time the Dream won that many games in a row was in 2018, when the team went on a 6-0 run from August 3-12 (the Dream made a Playoff run that season, going to five games against Washington in the Semifinals).

## **Returning Players**

Dream veteran Tiffany Hayes returned to the Dream's roster this season after choosing to sit out the 2020 WNBA season. Hayes comes back to the league after leading Perfumerias Avenida in Spain to a Endesa Women's League championship and a EuroLeague finals

appearance.

In addition to Hayes, the Dream are returning six players from the 2020 season, four of which have yet to play a true home game in Atlanta as they were added just prior to the league's Florida bubble season. Chennedy Carter, Shekinna Stricklen and Courtney Williams will all play their first season calling Atlanta home in 2021.

WNBA All-Rookie honoree Carter and WNBA All-Defensive team member Elizabeth Williams return after impressive performances in the WNBA bubble last season. Carter became the youngest player in league history to score 35 or more points, and Williams took over as the Dream's all-time leading shot blocker, tallying 288 over her five years with Atlanta. Monique Billings returns for her fourth season in a Dream uniform

#### **New Additions**

Five new players joined the team this year, with Tianna Hawkins, Cheyenne Parker and Odyssey Sims being picked up in free agency, Aari McDonald being drafted, and Crystal Bradford joining on a training camp contract.

The team acquired Cheyenne Parker as a free agent in the first day of the signing period after the 6-4 forward saw her most productive season of her six-year career, finishing the 2020 season averaging 13.4 points, 6.4 rebounds, 1.5 assists and 1.3 steals per game – all career-high numbers.Parker will be joined by 6-3 forward Tianna Hawkins in the frontcourt, a WNBA Champion with the Washington Mystics in 2019. Sims saw her most efficient season since her rookie year in 2020, shooting 33.3 percent from range and 90.9 percent from the free throw line with the Minnesota Lynx.

#### Dream Draft Three in 2021 WNBA Draft

The Dream drafted three players in the 2021 WNBA Draft, picking guard Aari McDonald out of Arizona with the third overall selection, Spanish star Raquel Carrera with the 15<sup>th</sup> overall pick and Lindsey Pulliam out of Northwestern with the 27<sup>th</sup> pick.

At Arizona, McDonald led the Wildcats to the team's first NCAA Finals appearance in 2021, averaging 24.8 points in their six games of the NCAA Tournament, including dropping 33 points against Indiana in the Elite Eight. The 5-6 guard earned Pac-12 Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year awards her redshirt senior year before becoming the first Wildcat to ever be drafted in the first round of a WNBA Draft.

McDonald is still working to finish her masters degree at Arizona, studying Applied Behavior Analysis.

## **2021 Dream Uniforms**

Entering the 2021 season, the WNBA and Nike have joined forces to tell H.E.R. story. The Dream worked with Nike to create three special uniforms that convey a message around the unique characteristics of Atlanta and to tell our story. The three uniforms have been given the names Heroine, Explorer and Rebel to highlight the power, potential and attitude of the WNBA athlete.

Atlanta Dream's Nike Heroine Edition in white and Atlanta Dream's Nike Explorer Edition in red uniforms capture the passion, courage and heart of the Georgians who championed the Civil Rights Movement. The belief in a more equitable tomorrow is amplified, represented by shimmering rays cast over a striking, bold red field — details that symbolize hope.

The colorful Atlanta Dream's Rebel Edition pays homage to the sound of Atlanta, defined by the city's unmatched impact on Hip-Hop and R&B. The legacy of the scene's legendary female recording artists is celebrated with vibrant colors, strapping side-striping, and confident lettering—a salute to the swagger, creativity and iconicity of ATL's most influential female musicians. The large ATL wordmark represents the city, while the side-panel design lines invoke vinyl records of the past and the ever-evolving sound of today's female artists. The subtle hints of silver in the uniform — such as the silver star and logo detailing — are symbolic of the platinum and gold records produced by the women of the city.

### **New Ownership Group**

WNBA and NBA Boards of Governors unanimously approved the sale of the Atlanta Dream to Larry Gottesdiener, Chairman of Northland, an industry-leading national real estate firm on February 26, 2021. The three-member investor group is comprised of former Dream star Renee Montgomery, Northland President and Chief Operating Officer Suzanne Abair, and Gottesdiener.

The sale made two-time WNBA champion Renee Montgomery the first former player to become both an owner and executive of a WNBA team. Montgomery sat out the 2020 season to focus on social justice issues and recently announced her retirement from the league after 11 seasons.



# COURTNEY WILLIAMS: WNBA ALL-STAR

**Courtney Williams** looks better than ever in her second year with Atlanta, averaging career numbers through her first nine games and earning her very first All-Star nod.

In the 2021 WNBA All-Star game, Williams shot 87.5% (7-8) off the bench to score 15 points for Team WNBA, adding on two assists, a steal and a block.

Now in her first season ever playing for the Dream in her home state, the Folkston, Ga. native is one of the team's top scorers and one of the most productive offensive players in the WNBA.

Williams is one of the best scorers in the league in clutch time, averaging 3.8 points (2<sup>nd</sup> in the league), 0.5 made three-pointers (1<sup>st</sup>), and 1.4 made field goals (2<sup>nd</sup>) in the final five minutes of close games.

She scored 5 of the Dream's 8 points in OT to help Atlanta beat New York on May 29, knocking down the final 2 three's to tie and then eventually win the game, earning her the Associated Press Player of the Week honor.

Williams recorded back-to-back double-doubles for the first time in her career after following her performance at New York with a 15 point/10 rebound game at Minnesota (6/4).

Williams is hitting 39.4% of her threes this season, nearly double her average of 23.5% in the Wubble. The only year she has finished over 40% was 2019 when she shot 45.7% in her final year with the Sun. However, Williams took just 1.0 three-point attempts per game that year. She's up to 3.6 this season after never taking more than 1.8 in any season prior.

# TIP HAYES

Dream veteran **Tiffany Hayes** returned this season after opting out of the 2020 bubble season, but her WNBA offseason was anything but a break. Hayes led her team, Perfumerias Avenida, to a Spanish League championship and a EuroLeague finals appearance earlier this year.

Hayes played in 11 of the first 12 games of the season, proving that she is still at the top of her game by putting up All-Star numbers, driving the Dream's offensive effort and creating pressure on defense. During the Dream's game at Washington on June 17, she tore her MCL and has missed the last seven games since sustaining her injury.

In that game against the Mystics, Hayes recorded a career-high five steals, becoming the first Dream player to acheive the stat since Renee Montgomery did it in 2018.

So far this season, Hayes is shooting 44.9% from beyond the arc. Her best season prior to 2021 was in 2013 when she shot 37.7% from range.

After her 49<sup>th</sup> career 20-point game against Seattle (6/9), scoring 22 points with 2 three's, she jumped up to an average of 18.6 points per game.

Her 17.6 current points per game ranks  $2^{nd}$  among all WNBA players this season.

# **RECENT MEETINGS WITH LOS ANGELES**

# **AUGUST 30, 2020**

BRADENTON, Fla. (AP) Brittney Sykes scored 15 points, Chelsea Gray had 14 - including back-to-back baskets in the final minute - and the Los Angeles Sparks beat the Atlanta Dream 84-79 on Sunday night to win their ninth consecutive game and clinch a spot in the WNBA playoffs.

Los Angeles is the third team to seal a playoff berth, joining the WNBA-leading Seattle and Las Vegas.

Nneka Ogwumike left in the first half and did not return for the Sparks due to a back injury. Kristine Anigwe started the second half in Ogwumike's place and finished with nine points and six rebounds. Candace Parker had just nine points on 4-of-11 shooting but added 10 rebounds and seven assists.

Chennedy Carter, who played 17 minutes Friday against Minnesota in her return from a five-game absence due to an ankle injury suffered on Aug. 10, led the Dream with 26 points on 11-of-19 shooting. Courtney Williams scored 15 points and Monique Billings added 12 points and 14 rebounds.

Carter made a layup to give Atlanta a 74-72 lead with 3:27 to play but Sykes scored the next six points before Parker made a driving layup as she was fouled but missed the and-1 free throw and it was 80-74 with 1:11 remaining. Carter and Gray each made layups before Billings converted a three-point play to make it 82-79 about 40 seconds later. But Gray dribbled into the lane, put on the brakes, and hit a fadeaway from the free-throw line with 8.1 seconds left and the Sparks held on.

# **AUGUST 21, 2020**

BRADENTON, Fla. (AP) Chelsea Gray scored 20 points, Candace Parker tied it in regulation and drew a key charge in overtime as the Los Angeles Sparks rallied to beat the Atlanta Dream 93-85 on Friday night.

Courtney Williams made a free-throw line jumper with 3.7 seconds left in regulation to give Atlanta a 79-77 lead. After a timeout, Parker took an inbound pass and drove the lane to tie it with a layup at the buzzer.

Glory Johnson opened the extra session with a long jumper, but Atlanta didn't score again until Betnijah Laney's basket with 35.9 seconds left.

Parker had 17 points, nine rebounds and five assists for Los Angeles (9-3), which has won six straight games. Sydney Wiese added 15 points, Nneka Ogwumike scored 14 and Brittney Sykes 12.

Johnson paced Atlanta (2-11) with 23 points on 10-of-16 shooting. Williams and Shekinna Stricklen each scored 16 points. Atlanta has lost 10 straight since beating New York on Julu 31.

Stricklen sank a contested 3-pointer with 6.3 seconds left in the third quarter to cap a 12-1 run for a 58-56 lead entering the fourth.

# **SEPTEMBER 3, 2019**

LOS ANGELES (AP) Candace Parker and Chiney Ogwumike each had double-doubles and Los Angeles overcame a slow start to beat the last-place Atlanta Dream 70-60 on Tuesday night in a game that put the Sparks in position to earn a first-round bye in the playoffs.

Parker had 21 points and 11 rebounds, Ogwumike 17 and 10. Ogwumike started for her sister Nneka, who was out with an illness that sidelined her for the second half of the team's last game against Las Vegas.

Chelsea Gray added 15 points.

After trailing by 11 after one quarter, the Sparks rallied in the second quarter, took the lead in the third and held off Atlanta to move a full game ahead of fifth-place Chicago with two games to play.

The Sparks (20-12) have won 12 straight at home, where they play their last two games. Los Angeles coach Derek Fisher became the ninth WNBA head coach to get to 20 wins in their first season. The record is 29 by the Sparks' Michael Cooper in 2000.

Atlanta shot 55% in the first quarter to 33% for the Sparks but a 7-0 run helped Los Angeles take a brief lead before the Dream took a 35-34 lead into the break. It was 51-45 for the Sparks after three quarters. The teams combined to go 7 of 40 from 3-point range.

Alex Bentley, who did not score in the second half, and Elizabeth Williams each had 15 points for Atlanta (7-25). The Dream are having their worst season since their inaugural season of 2008 (four wins).
