RGV ABOUT THE RIO GRANDE VALLEY VIPERS

The Rio Grande Valley Vipers were established by RGV Basketball, LLC in 2007 and are now entering their eighth season. The Vipers were originally affiliated with three teams during the first two seasons- the Houston Rockets, New Orleans Hornets and Cleveland Cavaliers. In 2009, the Houston Rockets basketball operations staff and Vipers owners pioneered the idea of single-affiliation, a concept that has since been adopted by 17 NBA organizations. The Vipers basketball operations area is managed by the Houston Rockets, while all business initiatives are managed locally by the team’s owners. The Vipers are coached by Nevada Smith.

The Vipers are one of the most successful franchises in the NBA Development League, boasting two Division Championships (2010 and 2013) and two NBA Development League Championships (2010 and 2013). RGV has also produced one Dennis Johnson Coach of the Year, current Houston Rockets assistant Chris Finch (2010), and two Most Valuable Players, Andrew Goudelock (2013) and Mike Harris (2010). Along with numerous awards, the Vipers hold the longest winning-streak in NBA Development League history with 19 regular-season games from March 16-Dec. 1, 2013, 25 straight games including the 2013 Championship run. Additionally, 30 former Vipers have received GATORADE Call-Ups and four former staff members are now part of NBA coaching staffs.

MAJORITY OWNER – ALONZO CANTU



Alonzo Cantu is the majority owner of the NBA Development League’s Rio Grande Valley Vipers. The team was founded in 2007 and is currently in its eighth season. The Vipers team was originally affiliated with the Cleveland Cavaliers, New Orleans Hornets and Houston Rockets. However, in 2009 the Rockets and Vipers pioneered the idea of hybrid affiliation and became the first NBA and NBA D-League teams with hybrid single-affiliation.

The RGV Vipers have won two NBA Development League Championships (2010 and 2013), along with two Division Titles (2010 and 2013). The 2012-13 squad was also awarded the 2013 NBA D- League Development Award, which recognizes the team that best embodies the NBA D- League’s goals of developing NBA-caliber basketball talent via call-ups and assignments.

The 2013-14 season was a record-breaking season for the Vipers. The team won its first nine games of the season, which combined a 10-game winning streak to end the 2012-13 season gave the Vipers the longest winning streak in NBA D-League history (19 games, 25 games including 2013 Playoffs). The Vipers also set the record for most three-point field goals in a season (801), and Houston Rockets Call-Up Troy Daniels set the NBA D-League individual record for three-point field goals made (240).

Throughout the team’s history, the Vipers have produced 29 GATORADE Call-Ups. Off the court, the front office has received league awards in attendance, sponsorship, ticket sales and community initiatives.

MEDIA CREDENTIALS

All media credentials for RGV Vipers home games at State Farm Arena should be requested at least 24 hours prior to the game media would like to attend. Requests should be made by email.

Media credentials can be picked up at the west entrance of State Farm Arena (near the loading dock) starting two hours prior to tipoff.

MEDIA PARKING

Parking is available on the west side of State Farm Arena. There is not a designated parking section for media.

DIRECTIONS TO STATE FARM ARENA

From McAllen Miller International Airport: Upon exiting airport, make right turn onto Wichita Street. At second light, make right turn onto 10th St. (Hwy 336). After 4.2 miles, arena will be on right.

From West: Take Expressway 83 to 10th St. Exit. Make right onto 10th St. After 4.7 miles, arena will be on right.

From East: Take Expressway 83 to 2nd St./10th St. Exit. Make left onto 10th St. After 4.8 miles, arena will be on right.

From North: Take Expressway 281 South to Expressway 83 West towards McAllen. After 3.3 miles, take 2nd St./10th St. Exit. Make left onto 10th St. After 4.8 miles, arena will be on right. OR Take Expressway 77 South to Expressway 83 North/West towards McAllen. After 33.2 miles, take 2nd St./10th St. Exit. Make left onto 10th St. After 4.8 miles, arena will be on right.

From Reynosa, Mexico: Take International Bridge to International Blvd. (Hidalgo). After 1.4 km, make slight right onto W. Coma Ave/TX-241/US-281. After 1.2 km, make slight left onto 10th St./336. After 2.3 km, arena will be on left.

From Mexico (East of Reynosa): Cross International Bridge and made left onto W. Military Hwy (US-281 West). Take right-hand exit onto 10th St. (towards McAllen). After 1.4 miles, arena will be on left. Arena is on the right hand side.

PRE AND POST GAME INTERVIEWS

Pre-Game: Vipers Head Coach Nevada Smith is available 75 minutes before home games, and approximately 90 minutes before games on the road (pending availability time for the opponent head coach when the Vipers are the visiting team). Vipers players are generally available before games during a 45-minute period that begins 90 minutes prior to tip-off.

Post-Game: Following a 10-minute cooling-off period, Coach Smith will be available outside the locker room for home games and outside the team locker room or courtside after road contests. Additionally, the Vipers dressing room will be opened no later than 15 minutes following the conclusion of the game. No still photos may be taken inside the dressing rooms, though video cameras are permitted. No autographs are allowed during media access periods.

PRACTICE DAY/SHOOT-AROUND INTERVIEWS

Vipers practices and shoot-arounds are open either the first 15 minutes or last 15 minutes. For up-to-date practice and shoot-around information email the director of media relations at rsweat@rgvipers.com.

GAME NOTES AND STATISTICS

Game notes, rosters and statistics are available two hours prior to tipoff on press row. Statistics will be printed quarterly for visiting media and scouts. Final post game statistics will be available after official review (approximately 10 minutes).

PHOTOGRAPHERS

Space is available along each baseline for photographers. Special requests for space or access must be made no later than 24 hours in advance.

BROADCAST

All RGV Vipers games are broadcast live and for free on the NBA Development League Network on YouTube. The majority of RGV Vipers games are broadcast live on Fox Sports 1700 AM and can also be heard via the iHeartRadio app. Radio broadcasts may be preempted for Dallas Cowboys broadcasts.

Played at California State Bakersfield from 2011-13... began his career at Utah State (2009-10)... averaged 9.8 ppg and 3.9 rpg his senior season... majored in Liberal Studies at CSU Bakersfield... originally from Portland, Oregon.

HEAD COACH: Nevada Smith – Second season with the RGV Vipers

COLLEGE: Bethany College

Nevada Smith enters his second season as head coach of the Rio Grande Valley Vipers. Smith is the fifth head coach in Vipers history.

In his first season as the Vipers head coach, Smith (69-36) led the Vipers to a 30-20 overall record. His coaching staff helped James Johnson, Chris Johnson and Troy Daniels earn GATORADE Call-Ups. The squad won the first nine games of the season, which combined with 2012-13's 10-game win-streak became the longest win-streak in NBA Development League history. Throughout the season, the team earned national attention for its fast-paced style and three-point shooting. The 2013-14 Vipers were 801-of-2268 from three-point range.

Midway through the season, the Vipers held the highest league winning percentage (19-6 as of Jan. 26), which earned Smith's staff the opportunity to coach Team Prospects at the 2014 NBA Development League All-Star Game in New Orleans, in conjunction with the annual NBA All-Star Weekend. Team Prospects topped Team Futures 145-142, and Houston Rockets assignee Robert Covington's 33 points earned him MVP honors.

Smith joined the Vipers after two seasons as the head coach of the Keystone College Giants in La Plume, Penn. During the 2012-13 season, the Giants compiled an 18-10 overall record. The Giants were 13-5 in Colonial State Athletic Conference (CSAC) action. The Giants finished the 2011-12 season with a 21-6 record. For the first time in school history, the Giants reached the CSAC Championship Game in both seasons under Smith.

Prior to joining Keystone, Coach Smith spent five years as an assistant coach at Ithaca College. During his time at Ithaca, the Bombers saw their best five-year stretch in program history, compiling a mark of 96-40. Over this period, Ithaca claimed three Empire 8 regular season championships in 2008, 2009 and 2011, and two NCAA Tournament berths in 2009 and 2011. That timeframe also included an ECAC title in 2010 and five appearances in the Empire 8 Championship Tournament.

Before joining Ithaca, Smith was at Allegheny College where he was an assistant varsity coach and the Gators head junior varsity coach for the 2005-06 season. Prior to his arrival at Allegheny, Smith served as head coach at Canton for the 2004-05 season, coaching one All-Region and two All-Conference picks. He also served as an assistant coach at St. Lawrence University from 2002-04, a stretch that saw the team compile a 34-18 mark, including a 2003-04 UCAA Regular Season title.

During his playing days, Smith was a four-year starter at Bethany College, scoring 1,255 points to rank fifth on the program's all-time scoring list. He led the nation in three-point field goals per game in 2000-01 and his 313 career three-point baskets rank 13th among all NCAA Division III players. As a senior, Smith helped the Bisons to a school-record 21 wins and the program's first NCAA playoff appearance in 20 years. He also demonstrated his athletic ability on the links for Bethany as a three-year team captain and a Second-Team All-PAC selection in golf. On Oct. 8, Smith was inducted into the Bethany Athletics Hall of Fame.

Smith is a 2002 graduate of Bethany College and received his Master's from St. Lawrence University.
