GAME 7: DID YOU KNOW?

- There have been 139 Game 7s in NBA history.
- Home teams have a record of 108-31 (.777) in Game 7s.
- Every active NBA franchise has played at least one Game 7.
- There have been 19 Game 7s in the NBA Finals, with home teams holding a 15-4 record. The most recent Game 7 in the NBA Finals came in 2016, when the Cleveland Cavaliers defeated the host Golden State Warriors to become the first team to come back from a 3-1 deficit to win the Finals.
- The first Game 7 in NBA history took place on April 6, 1948, when the Philadelphia Warriors (now the Golden State Warriors) defeated the St. Louis Bombers 85-46 in the Semifinals.
- Bill Russell won all 10 Game 7s in which he played, the most victories without a loss for a player.



- Ten players have recorded a triple-double in a Game 7: Jerry West, Larry Bird, James Worthy, Scottie Pippen, Russell Westbrook (two), Rajon Rondo (two), Blake Griffin, LeBron James, Nikola Jokić (two) and Chris Paul.
- The NBA record for most points by a player in a Game 7 is 47, shared by the Boston Celtics' Sam Jones (1963 Eastern Division Finals against the Cincinnati Royals) and the Atlanta Hawks' Dominique Wilkins (1988 Eastern Conference Semifinals against Boston).
- The record for most points by a player in Game 7 of the NBA Finals is 42, by the Los Angeles Lakers' Jerry West against the Boston Celtics in 1969.
- Philadelphia 76ers head coach Doc Rivers has served as a head coach in a record 14 Game 7s. Pat Riley (11) and Larry Brown (10) rank second and third, respectively, in most Game 7s coached.
- Red Auerbach won all eight of his Game 7s as a head coach, the most victories without a loss for a head coach.
- LeBron James has scored the most total points in Game 7s with 279 one more than Jerry West. (James has appeared in eight Game 7s and West played in nine.)
- The first Game 7 in the NBA Finals took place in 1951, when the Rochester Royals (now the Sacramento Kings) defeated the New York Knicks 79-75. In that series, New York lost the first three games before winning the next three games to force a Game 7.

GAME 7: DID YOU KNOW?

- In addition to the New York Knicks in the 1951 NBA Finals, two other teams have rallied from a 3-0 series deficit to force a Game 7: the Denver Nuggets against the Utah Jazz in the 1994 Western Conference Semifinals and the Portland Trail Blazers against the Dallas Mavericks in the 2003 Western Conference First Round.
- Ray Allen played in a record 11 Game 7s. Paul Pierce and Bill Russell are tied for the second-most Game 7s played with 10 each.
- The first round of the 2014 NBA Playoffs had five Game 7s, a record for any round in a season. A record three Game 7s were played on one day.
- The record for most Game 7s in a single season is five, which happened in 1994, 2014 and 2016.
- The Boston Celtics have played a record 33 Game 7s or 24% of all Game 7s in NBA history. Boston has a 24-9 record (.727) in Game 7s.
- The Los Angeles Lakers have a 16-8 record (.667) in Game 7s 15-1 at home and 1-7 on the road. The Lakers' one road victory in Game 7 came in overtime against the Sacramento Kings in the 2002 Western Conference Finals.



2019 Eastern Conference Semifinals (May 12, 2019)

Kawhi Leonard hit a fadeaway baseline jump shot that bounced off the rim four times before falling to give the Toronto Raptors a 92-90 home victory over the Philadelphia 76ers. Leonard's basket, which gave him 41 points, marked the first game-winning buzzer beater in a Game 7 in NBA history.

2016 NBA Finals (June 19, 2016)

The Cleveland Cavaliers defeated the host Golden State Warriors 93-89 to earn their first NBA championship. Cleveland became the first team to overcome a 3-1 series deficit to win the NBA Finals, ending a 52-year title drought for major pro sports teams in Cleveland. The Cavaliers produced two signature plays late in Game 7: LeBron James' block on a layup attempt by Andre Iguodala to keep the game tied with just under two minutes remaining, and Kyrie Irving's go-ahead three-pointer with 53 seconds left.

2015 Western Conference First Round (May 2, 2015)

Chris Paul banked in a 9-foot shot with one second left to give the LA Clippers a 111-109 home victory over the defending NBA champion San Antonio Spurs.

2014 First Round (May 3 and 4, 2014)

The first round featured a record five Game 7s, including a record three Game 7s on the same day. The five Game 7s: Brooklyn Nets over Toronto Raptors; Indiana Pacers over Atlanta Hawks; LA Clippers over Golden State Warriors; Oklahoma City Thunder over Memphis Grizzlies; and San Antonio Spurs over Dallas Mavericks.

2013 NBA Finals (June 20, 2013)

LeBron James scored 37 points and grabbed 12 rebounds as the Miami Heat defeated the visiting San Antonio Spurs 95-88 to win its second straight NBA championship.

2010 NBA Finals (June 17, 2010)

The Los Angeles Lakers rallied from a 13-point third-quarter deficit to defeat the visiting Boston Celtics 83-79, winning their second straight NBA championship. Los Angeles' Phil Jackson won his 11th and final NBA championship as a head coach, the most in league history.

2008 Eastern Conference Semifinals (May 18, 2008)


Paul Pierce scored 41 points as the Boston Celtics overcame 45 points by LeBron James to defeat the visiting Cleveland Cavaliers 97-92.

2006 Western Conference Semifinals (May 22, 2006)

The visiting Dallas Mavericks defeated the defending NBA champion San Antonio Spurs 119-111 in overtime. After leading by 20 points in the second quarter, the Mavericks needed a game-tying three-point play from Dirk Nowitzki (37 points, 15 rebounds) with 21 seconds left in regulation to set up the overtime period. The Spurs' Tim Duncan finished with 41 points, 15 rebounds, six assists and three blocks.

2004 Western Conference Semifinals (May 19, 2004)

Kevin Garnett finished with 32 points, 21 rebounds, five blocks and four steals as the host Minnesota Timberwolves defeated the Sacramento Kings 83-80 to advance to the Western Conference Finals for the first time. Chris Webber's potential game-tying three-pointer rimmed out at the buzzer for Sacramento.



2002 Western Conference Finals (June 2, 2002)

The two-time defending NBA champion Los Angeles Lakers defeated the host Sacramento Kings 112-106 in overtime, completing their comeback from a 3-2 series deficit.

2001 Eastern Conference Semifinals (May 20, 2001)

Vince Carter narrowly missed a potential game-winning jump shot just before the buzzer as the Philadelphia 76ers held on to defeat the visiting Toronto Raptors 88-87.

2000 Western Conference Finals (June 4, 2000)

Down 15 points with 10:28 remaining in the fourth quarter, the Los Angeles Lakers rallied to defeat the visiting Portland Trail Blazers 89-84. The comeback was punctuated by Shaquille O'Neal's memorable alley-oop dunk via a pass from Kobe Bryant.

2000 Eastern Conference Semifinals (May 21, 2000)

Meeting in the playoffs for the fourth consecutive season, the New York Knicks defeated the host Miami Heat 83-82.

1998 Eastern Conference Finals (May 31, 1998)

The two-time defending NBA champion Chicago Bulls defeated the visiting Indiana Pacers 88-83 in Game 7 of the 1998 Eastern Conference Finals. The game was tied with five minutes left and the Bulls led by two points with two minutes remaining.

1995 Eastern Conference Semifinals (May 21, 1995)

Patrick Ewing narrowly missed a potential game-tying finger roll just before the buzzer as the Indiana Pacers held off the host New York Knicks 97-95. Ewing finished with 29 points, 14 rebounds, five assists and four blocks.

1995 Western Conference Semifinals (May 20, 1995)

Mario Elie made a go-ahead three-pointer with 7.1 seconds remaining as the Houston Rockets defeated the host Phoenix Suns 115-114. Houston became the fifth team in NBA history and the first in 14 years to rally from a 3-1 deficit to win a playoff series. Phoenix's Kevin Johnson finished with 46 points and 10 assists.

1994 NBA Finals (June 22, 1994)

Hakeem Olajuwon finished with 25 points, 10 rebounds and seven assists as the Houston Rockets defeated the visiting New York Knicks 90-84 to win their first NBA championship.

1993 Western Conference Semifinals (May 22, 1993)


After trailing by 10 points at halftime, the Seattle SuperSonics rallied to defeat the visiting Houston Rockets 103-100 in overtime.

1990 Western Conference Semifinals (May 19, 1990)

Down by seven points with 2½ minutes left in regulation, the Portland Trail Blazers rallied to defeat the visiting San Antonio Spurs 108-105 in overtime. Portland's Terry Porter scored a game-high 36 points.

1988 NBA Finals (June 21, 1988)

James Worthy finished with 36 points, 16 rebounds and 10 assists for his first career triple-double to lead the Los Angeles Lakers past the visiting Detroit Pistons 108-105. The Lakers won their second straight NBA championship.



1988 Eastern Conference Semifinals (May 22, 1988)

Larry Bird scored 20 of his 34 points in the fourth quarter as the Boston Celtics overcame 47 points by Dominique Wilkins to defeat the visiting Atlanta Hawks 118-116.

1987 Eastern Conference Finals: (May 30, 1987)

Larry Bird finished with 37 points, nine rebounds and nine assists as the defending NBA champion Boston Celtics overcame 35 points by Joe Dumars to defeat the visiting Detroit Pistons 117-114.

1987 Eastern Conference Semifinals (May 17, 1987)

The Boston Celtics rallied from an eight-point deficit midway through the fourth quarter to defeat the visiting Milwaukee Bucks 119-113.

1986 Eastern Conference Semifinals (May 11, 1986)

The Milwaukee Bucks held on to defeat the visiting Philadelphia 76ers 113-112 as Julius Erving missed a potential go-ahead jump shot with three seconds remaining.

1982 Eastern Conference Finals (May 23, 1982)

Andrew Toney scored 34 points as the visiting Philadelphia 76ers defeated the defending NBA champion and top-seeded Boston Celtics 120-106.

1981 Eastern Conference Finals (May 3, 1981)

The Boston Celtics rallied from a double-digit deficit for the third consecutive game to defeat the visiting Philadelphia 76ers 91-90, completing their comeback from a 3-1 series deficit. This marked the fourth consecutive game decided by two points or fewer in the series.

1981 Eastern Conference Semifinals (April 19, 1981)

Leading by one point and inbounding the ball with nine seconds left, the Philadelphia 76ers managed to run out the clock to hold off the visiting Milwaukee Bucks 99-98.

1981 Western Conference Semifinals (April 17, 1981)

Calvin Murphy scored 42 points to lead the Houston Rockets past the host San Antonio Spurs 105-100.

1979 Eastern Conference Finals (May 18, 1979)


Bob Dandridge scored 37 points and made a go-ahead jump shot with seven seconds remaining as the Washington Bullets rallied from a 10-point fourth-quarter deficit to defeat the visiting San Antonio Spurs 107-105, completing their comeback from a 3-1 series deficit. Washington's Elvin Hayes finished with 25 points, 15 rebounds and seven blocked shots, including a block on the final possession to seal the victory. San Antonio's George Gervin scored 42 points.

1978 NBA Finals (June 7, 1978)

The Washington Bullets defeated the host Seattle SuperSonics 105-99 to win their first NBA championship.

1976 Eastern Conference Semifinals (April 29, 1976)

Dick Snyder made a go-ahead layup with four seconds left as the Cleveland Cavaliers defeated the visiting Washington Bullets 87-85 to advance to the Eastern Conference Finals in the franchise's playoff debut.





1971 Eastern Conference Finals (April 19, 1971)

Wes Unseld deflected Bill Bradley's potential game-tying jump shot in the closing seconds as the visiting Washington Bullets defeated the defending NBA champion New York Knicks 93-91 to advance to the NBA Finals for the first time.

1970 NBA Finals (May 8, 1970)

After 1969-70 NBA MVP Willis Reed famously jolted the Madison Square Garden crowd when he limped onto the court for Game 7, the New York Knicks defeated the Los Angeles Lakers 113-99 to win their first NBA championship. New York's Walt Frazier finished with 36 points, 19 assists and seven rebounds.

1969 NBA Finals (May 5, 1969)

The Boston Celtics defeated the host Los Angeles Lakers 108-106 to win their 11th championship in 13 seasons. The classic conclusion to a riveting series marked the final career games for Celtics legends Bill Russell and Sam Jones. The Lakers' Jerry West, who finished with 42 points, 13 rebounds and 12 assists in Game 7, was named the first NBA Finals MVP after averaging 37.9 points in the series. He remains the only Finals MVP from a losing team.

1968 Eastern Division Finals (April 19, 1968)

The Boston Celtics defeated the host Philadelphia 76ers 100-96 to become the first team in NBA history to come back from a 3-1 deficit to win a best-of-seven playoff series.

1966 NBA Finals (April 28, 1966)

Bill Russell scored 25 points and grabbed 32 rebounds as the Boston Celtics defeated the visiting Los Angeles Lakers 95-93 to win the last of their eight consecutive NBA championships and send Red Auerbach out a winner in his final game as their head coach.

1965 Eastern Division Finals (April 15, 1965)

Boston Celtics clinging to a one-point lead over the Philadelphia 76ers with five seconds remaining, Boston's John Havlicek famously tipped away Philadelphia's inbounds pass. Teammate Sam Jones grabbed the loose ball and dribbled out the clock as the Celtics prevailed 110-109 in Boston to advance to the NBA Finals (where they defeated the Los Angeles Lakers for their seventh straight title). Jones scored 37 points. Philadelphia's Wilt Chamberlain finished with 30 points and 32 rebounds.

1963 Eastern Division Finals (April 10, 1963)

Sam Jones scored 47 points as the four-time defending NBA champion Boston Celtics overcame 43 points by Oscar Robertson to defeat the visiting Cincinnati Royals 142-131.

1962 NBA Finals (April 18, 1962)

Bill Russell scored 30 points and tied his own NBA Finals record with 40 rebounds as the host Boston Celtics defeated the Los Angeles Lakers 110-107 in overtime. The classic game ended with Bob Cousy famously scurrying around the court with a clock-burning dribbling display, sealing the fourth of the Celtics' eight straight NBA championships. The Lakers' Elgin Baylor scored 41 points and grabbed 22 rebounds.

1962 Eastern Division Finals (April 5, 1962)

Sam Jones made a go-ahead jump shot with two seconds remaining to give the host Boston Celtics a 109-107 victory over the Philadelphia Warriors.



1961 Western Division Finals (April 1, 1961)

Bob Pettit (31 points, 17 rebounds), Woody Sauldsberry (22 points, 13 rebounds), Lenny Wilkens (21 points, 12 rebounds) and Cliff Hagan (21 points, 11 rebounds) led the host St. Louis Hawks past the Los Angeles Lakers 105-103. Elgin Baylor scored 39 points for Los Angeles.

1959 Eastern Division Finals (April 1, 1959)

Bill Russell scored 18 points and grabbed 32 rebounds as the Boston Celtics rallied from a 16-point deficit to defeat the visiting Syracuse Nationals 130-125. Boston went on to win the first of its eight consecutive NBA championships.

1957 NBA Finals (April 13, 1957)

The Boston Celtics outlasted the visiting St. Louis Hawks 125-123 in double overtime to win their first NBA championship. Celtics rookies Bill Russell (19 points, 32 rebounds) and Tom Heinsohn (37 points, 23 rebounds) combined for 56 points and 55 rebounds to counter Bob Pettit's 39 points and 19 rebounds for the Hawks.

1955 NBA Finals (April 10, 1955)

The Syracuse Nationals rallied from a 17-point second-quarter deficit to defeat the visiting Fort Wayne Pistons 92-91.

1951 NBA Finals (April 21, 1951)

In the first Game 7 in NBA Finals history, the host Rochester Royals defeated the New York Knicks 79-75. Game 7 capped a dramatic series in which the Royals won the first three games and the Knicks won the next three games. The Knicks remain the only team in Finals history to force a Game 7 after trailing 3-0.

1948 Semifinals (April 6, 1948)

In the first Game 7 in NBA history, the Philadelphia Warriors defeated the host St. Louis Bombers 85-46 to advance to the NBA Finals.
